**RE:** 2020 General Election Results

Florida's 2020 General Election was truly one for the history books as voters turned out in unprecedented numbers. Voter turnout in many counties across the state reached some of the highest numbers ever seen. Additionally, for the first time in modern U.S. history, there were more voters who voted early than on Election Day, shattering all previous records for early voting.

As you can see in the previous illustration, the state's traditional two-party system continues to shift with a dramatic increase in the number of voters who do not identify with either traditional party. Voters who registered as NPA (No Party Affiliation) or "Other" continue to increase at a rapid pace and almost represent one-third of the electorate. This shift in voter registration away from the two major parties is making it increasingly difficult to predict voter behavior.

The most significant gains in voter registration leading up to the general election, were made by Republicans who saw tremendous strides in narrowing the gap between them and those voters who registered as Democrats.

This year's Florida's 2020 General Election included not only the Presidential race, but also 26 Congressional races, 96 House races, and 20 Senate races (including a special election). Election Day had a 77% voter turnout, representing the highest turnout in years, with approximately 11.1 million voters voting. However, more than 4.8 million voters voted by mail and over 4.3 million voted during early voting.

Democrats accounted for approximately 2,188,355 vote-by-mail ballots compared to 1,506,123 for Republicans, but Republicans had more early voters with 1,959,875 compared to 1,401,451 for Democrats. These numbers reflect a slight change in their historical turnout in which Republicans typically have a higher number of absentee voting and Democrats are stronger in early voting. Interestingly, Republicans enjoyed a massive edge on election day as voters turned out in much higher numbers.

Some of the major surprises in the General Election included the defeat of four current legislators - one Senator and three House members. These defeats included Senator Jose Javier Rodriguez (D-Miami), Representative Jennifer Webb (D-Gulfport), Representative Delores Hogan-Johnson (D-Fort Pierce) and Representative Cindy Polo (D-Miramar).

The Senate began the 2020 Election with nine open seats – three Democratic seats and six Republican seats. There was a total of ten candidates for the Florida Senate who were elected for the first time in the General Election. There were also ten incumbents running for the Florida Senate who were re-elected in the General Election.

While there were several hotly contested races in the Senate, the 10-member freshman class includes eight individuals who previously served in the Florida House. Look for someone from this "class" to start campaigning for the post of Senate President in 2025. And as Republicans picked up a seat, their majority improved from 23-17 to a 24-16 advantage in the Senate.

#### FLORIDA HOUSE GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS

There was a total of 28 candidates running for the House in the General Election who were elected to serve in the Legislature for the first time. There were also 67 incumbents running for the House who were re-elected in the General Election. Unlike the Senate, the amount of "open" seats for the 2020 Election were nearly equally split between Republicans (14) and Democrats (15).

The House also saw several hotly contested races in both the Primary and General Election. Some of the seats were open due to term limits and others due to members running for another office or even being appointed to the Public Service Commission. In the end, the incumbents in these key races kept their seats. And as Republicans picked up five seats, their majority improved from 73-47 to a 78-42 advantage in the House. This majority is just two shy of the coveted "super-majority".

#### **CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS**

Finally, in addition to the Senate, House and Congressional races, there were also six proposed Constitutional Amendments on the ballot. Each amendment needed 60% of the total vote to be to be approved by the voters and added to the Florida Constitution. Florida voters approved four of the six amendments to be placed in the Constitution. These are Amendments 1, 2, 5 and 6. Amendment 2 which allows for an increase in Florida's minimum wage to \$15 by 2026 is most controversial amendment that passed on the ballot this election.
