# **2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION STATS**

2016	1814	279 (15%)
2017	1922	249 (13%)
2018	1878	200 (11%)
2019	1861	197 (10%)
2020	1883	210 (11%)

### **FY 2020-21 BUDGET**

- Legislature began the budget conference process \$1.4 billion apart.
- The two sides were unable to reach an agreement on a new budget during the 60-day session and were forced to extend it an additional 6 days past March 13.
- Legislature approved a \$93.2 billion budget.
- Governor vetoed over \$1 billion, approved \$92.2 billion budget for FY 2020-21.

### FLORIDA SENATE - 2020 Elections


- 68 Candidates, including incumbents, have filed to run
